1.	Macabeo Borsao Campo De Borja <i>Pale straw in color with green hints. Fresh, lightly savory nose of lemon and fennel. Peachy and cashew nut characters on the palate. A clean, fruity finish.</i>	Spain	£13.95 £3.95
2.	Pinot Grigio Principato 2009 <i>Pale straw yellow color, delicate floral and fruity aromas, crisp and fresh on the palate. Highly versatile.</i>	Italy	£16.95
3.	Sauvignon Blanc/ Semillon Thandi Fairtrade <i>A bold blend with tropical fruit with touches of passion fruit and lime with asparagus and pepper flavors coming through from the Sauvignon Blanc a crisp and mineral finish.</i>	South Africa	£19.95
4.	Torrontes Urban 2008 <i>The range stands out as 'interesting' wines with real character. A crisp, refreshing take on a local favorite – packed with fresh pear and kiwi fruit, crisp minerality.</i>	Argentina	£20.95
5.	Riesling Reserve Turckheim 2007 <i>This bottle has a powerful citrus and floral fruit characters balanced with great minerality and a long crisp finish.</i>	Alsace	£22.95
6.	Gavi di Gavi <i>Unoaked, fresh and minerally Gavi can be compared to Chablis, which makes it very good for partnering with fish and seafood.</i>	Italy	£24.95
7.	Chenin Coriole McLaren Vale 2009 <i>Green apple, passionfruit and lemon blossom are immediately obvious with a nice clean crisp finish. This bottle is good, clean fun perfect for a sunny afternoon.</i>	Australia	£26.95

8. **Chardonnay Mulderbosch 2007** South Africa £29.95
Orange blossom, lemon grass and lemon rind on the nose. A full rich palate with lively acidity.
9. **Sancerre Cedrick Bardin 2008** Loire £31.95
Made from 100% Sauvignon Blanc grown on silex soils. The wine is clean and fresh and full of green skinned fruit flavors.
10. **Chablis 1er Cru Montmain Berangere 2007** Burgundy £35.95
Medium-bodied with apply fruit, yeasty notes and a strong backbone with the characteristic flinty finish.
11. **Sauvignon Blanc Cloudy Bay Marlborough** New Zealand £42.95
The wine is certainly a head-turner. With up-front gooseberry, green pepper and elderflower character typical of the region, together with a touch of fatness from the oak and often a slight dash of Semillon.

Red Wines

12. **Garnacha Tinto Borsao Campo de Borja** Spain £13.95 £3.95
Similar to Tempranillo which contains bright aromas of fresh red berries (raspberry), a chunk of vanilla oak spice, some black fruits and a hint of violet
13. **Merlot Sierra Cruz** Chile £16.95
Deep red, ripe soft fruits, plums on the nose. Soft tannins rich soft red fruits/plum in the mouth medium finish
14. **Cotes du Rhone La Griveliere** Rhone £17.95
Clean with low/medium intensity of raspberry and licorice.
15. **Shiraz/ Cabernet Sauvignon Thandi Fairtrade** South Africa £19.95
A concentrated, full-bodied modern blend with upfront dark berries and smoky aromas, smooth ripe tannins and a lingering aftertaste.

RESTAURANT WITH ROOMS

16. **Malbec Urban 2008** **Argentina** **£20.95**
There is masses of totally natural ripe fruit here with more than a whiff of high altitude and it does not feel excessive on the palate.
17. **Merlot Reserva Tabali Limari 2006** **Chile** **£23.95**
Dense in color with deep, plummy, but accessible fruit showing fine breadth of flavor with gentle tannins and a long finish
18. **Vega Del Rayo Reserva Rioja** **Spain** **£25.95**
It has a nose of plums and wild blackberry with hints of citrus fruits and raisins. The sweet vanilla and brown spices from ageing in wood, are well balanced.
19. **Chateau Rousseau de Sipian 2002** **Bordeaux** **£27.95**
Dark, concentrated colour. Just a little more purple youth than the 2001. Sweet, crunchy blackcurrant fruit, blended with some green pepper, tobacco and violets. Intensely smoky. Good extract, but moderate concentration at best
20. **Pinot Noir Manawa Marlborough 2007** **New Zealand** **£31.95**
Luscious and lively, supple and silky, bursting with berry flavors, Pinot Noir is a sensual wine that invites drinkers to get personal. Marlborough's distinctive pungent fruit flavors and dense structure, in Pinot Noir are attributed to the steady marine influence.
21. **Fleure Les Roche du Vivier 2008** **Burgundy** **£32.95**
This wine produces light to medium bodied wines with modest tannins and good acidity, and produces wonderful, cherry and raspberry flavored wines with earthy hints of violets and spice.
22. **Chateau Cissac Cru Bourgeois** **France** **£39.95**
Cabernet Sauvignon provides unmistakable aromas of cassis. Merlot and petit verdot add plumpness and complexity in what is a most elegant, classic medoc.
23. **Barolo Patrizi 2005** **Italy** **£40.95**
Deep garnet in color, with an open and spicy nose with notes of dried fruits, woodsmoke and leather. Full flavored with good concentration of approachable damson and wild cherry fruit, and warm and velvety mid-palate of coffee and chocolate, leading to a long finish, supported by bracing acidity and firm tannins

	<i>Pale pink. Fruit aromas with cherry overtones. A fine, pleasant and balanced flavor.</i>
